New Court Reservation System

Dear Members,

We are excited to announce that we're switching to a new reservation system for the sports courts. This proven system has been successfully implemented at other clubs for over two decades. It's designed to be user-friendly, efficient, and better tailored to your needs.

The new system will go live on Monday, February 3. Until then, reservations for tennis, pickleball, and basketball courts will still be taken under the current system. Any reservations made before February 3 for dates after February 3 will automatically transition to the new system.



LETTER FROM THE DIRECTOR OF TENNIS AND SPORTS

Key Features of the New System:

- Online Access: Members can log in to view the full court schedule and make their own reservations without needing to call or visit the Golf Pro Shop.
- Personal Accounts: Each member will have a unique username and password, ensuring secure access and preventing others from modifying your reservations.

How to Get Started:

1. Visit the new reservation website: Eaglebrooke.OnlineCourtReservations.com (note: do not include “www.”).
2. Your username will be “first name.last name.”
3. Email me at Greg.Jones@Eaglebrooke.com to set up your password. You will have the option to customize it later.

Reservation Guidelines:

- Use the dropdown menu to select your desired reservation time (30, 60, or 90 minutes).
- Include all players’ full names (first and last) in your reservation.
- Guest fees will be charged to your member account.
- You will receive a confirmation email upon completing your reservation.
- Reservations can be made up to 3 days in advance, plus the current day (e.g., on Monday, you can reserve for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday).

A complete set of rules will be available on the new reservation system. If you have any questions or need assistance setting up your account, feel free to email me at Greg.Jones@Eaglebrooke.com.

LETTER FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

With the cooler temperatures, the turf has nearly gone dormant, and we're seeing very little growth, resulting in minimal clippings in our mower baskets. Mowing frequency on tees, fairways, and collars has been reduced to once per week, mainly to clean things up and chop divots. This has given us time to focus on landscaping beds and minor tree work to improve the course's overall appearance. Toward the end of the month, we'll resume some spraying for fertility and weed prevention.

This winter has been one of the coldest we've experienced in several years. We've already had a few frost mornings, with several near misses where the prevailing wind kept frost from forming. It's important to remember that frost can develop anytime the temperature is between 32 and 40 degrees. Walking or driving on frosted turf can puncture the plant with ice crystals, causing injury that lasts until the growing season begins again. That's why we monitor these chilly, damp mornings closely to protect the turf.

Looking ahead, I'm planning to get an early start on our pre-emergent weed program. At the end of February, we'll apply a fertilizer and pre-emergent combo. While we've traditionally used Ronstar, this year we'll switch to Barricade. Both are effective but work differently within the plant, and this rotation helps prevent resistance buildup. This application will target spring broadleaf weeds, early goosegrass, and some crabgrass while providing Bermuda grass with an early boost of nutrients as temperatures warm up.

Lastly, the countdown to our renovation project is on, and I couldn't be more excited! We have some hard work ahead, but the crew is ready, and we're putting key pieces in place to ensure success. I'm eager to get started and see the results of this important project. Thank you for your continued support, and we look forward to keeping the course in great shape for the season ahead!

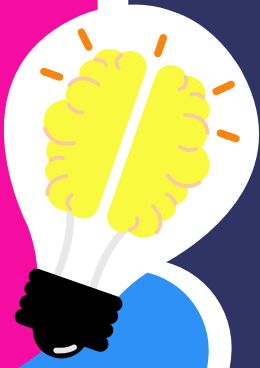
